- *Student Directed Inquiry, Level 3*

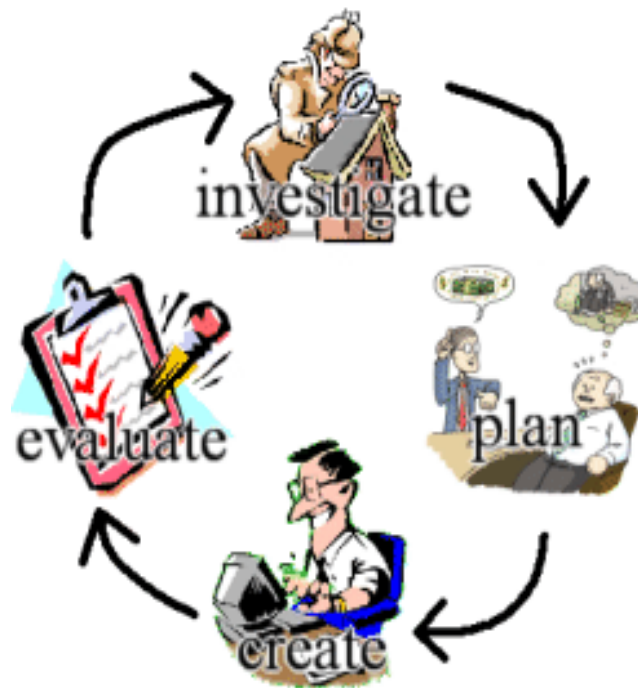
Also a range of Vocational Education and Training (VET) programs or tertiary study in areas such as

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

### Design and Production - Level 2

#### Looks at:

Using the design process in response to design briefs to produce/make a range of items from textiles such as

- clothing
- wearable art
- artefacts
- accessories
- cushions
- bags
- recycled/remodelled clothing.

#### No Pre-requisites

## STUDY INCLUDES

- Students use technical skills and processes relevant to textile production.
- Design and production phases are reviewed and reflected on and adjust design decisions throughout the process.
- Learners build the skills in planning and implementing projects, enabling them to manage resources effectively.
- A design folio records the design process for a major practical project.
